

# CIT All College Meeting Minutes

Date: Wednesday, August 10, 2005, 2:00pm

Dean Bradford opened the meeting welcoming everyone back, by giving a brief history of the College, and by giving a special thank you to Dr. Williams, Dr. Cook, and Dr. Reichgelt by a presentation of gifts.

Dean Bradford gave a brief progress report on leadership and staffing:

- New IT Department Chair, Dr. Art Gowan
- A promotion from within, CS Department Chair, Dr. Jim Harris
- Continuation of IS Department Chair, Dr. Susan Williams
- Changes in Student Services – Department reports to Dean Bradford, Student Services now has 2 full-time academic advisor positions hired a former graduate assistant, Maria Aviles, as an advisor
- New faculty – John O'Malley, IT Department
- IS search underway for Associate and Senior Professor
- CS search to fill Jim Harris position begins in Fall
- IS Department Secretary, Donna Orme
- Tech Support, Scott Dodson
- Student Services has a secretary position open

Departmental Reports:

Computer Sciences – Dr. Jim Harris reports the CS Master's Degree Proposal is still in progress, UPE Inauguration, 2006 ACM Programming Contest possibly being held here at GSU and possibly a good recruiting tool for the college, CS Web page has been updated. Dr. Bob Cook shared his summer research project at NASA, worked on an Enrichment Website for Middle/High School students

Information Systems – Dr. Susan Williams welcomed Beverly Frazier to the team as a full-time temporary faculty, IS now has 20 faculty/temporary employed, Max Burns will be returning this Fall to teach an elective course, 7 emphasis areas have been approved, Master's Proposal still in progress, has two searches on the way with over 200 applications, sent 7 faculty for SAP training this summer, the reunion is set for November 4-5, CIT Golf Tournament will be the day before Homecoming, National IS Exit Exam.

Information Technology – Dr. Art Gowan formally welcomed John O'Malley, IT is still waiting for news from ABET, had 15 graduates last Fall and 18 graduates in the Spring, WebBSIT.

Student Services – Maria Aviles reiterated on the 2 full-time academic advisor positions they now have, Student Services advises 330 IT and 120 Pre-CS students, their goal for the upcoming year is to follow-up on student performance, 100 students attended the Soar sessions and 90% of the students that signed up for CIT during Soar stayed with the college.

Tech Support – Joey Reeves advised that they are still imaging the labs, Rm 3210 will be getting 10 additional machines, new Eagle Lab hours (M-F 8am – 10pm & Sat-Sun 2pm – 10pm), they are looking for interns for the help desk, discussed server security issues, have a new video editing machine, will publish a listing of scantron machines over the campus, Scott Dodson received Red Hat certification, Shawne Zuber received certification in Network Plus.

NCR Project – Richard Chambers gave a brief report on what he and his team are working on.

SACS Accreditation and our Evolving Assessment Culture – Dr. Reichgelt presented a short presentation on why the emphasis on assessment has increased, and the learning and programmatic outcomes of assessment.
